

EMERGENCY ORDER DESIGNATING AN ALTERNATE FACILITY


WHEREAS, a Judicial Emergency has been previously determined to exist pursuant to both local orders and the Georgia Supreme Court, most recently on April 9, 2021 in this circuit and on April 8, 2021 in the State of Georgia;

WHEREAS, the Hall County Courthouse is not adequate and is impractical to handle the social distancing and health precautions as contained within the COVID-19 Jury Committee's *Hall County Guide for Resuming Jury Proceedings* (adopted October 15, 2020);

THEREFORE, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-61(c), Chief Judge Kathlene F. Gosselin of the Northeastern Judicial Circuit, does hereby DESIGNATE the Ramsey Conference Center of Lanier Technical College as an alternate courthouse during the period from June 21, 2021 through July 11, 2021 and finds that building to be a reasonably accessible and appropriate facility for conducting court business. The Ramsey Conference Center is located at 2535 Lanier Tech Drive in Gainesville, Georgia.

This Order shall be in effect so long as this circuit remains in a state of judicial emergency, whether by extension order of the undersigned or the Chief Justice.
